Dear Mr. Petrilli:

I have received your Maryland Public Information Act (MPIA) request seeking the recent three years for which data are available, how much did Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) spend on:

- The district's supplemental pension program. Not what MCPS spent on the core (state) pension program, or what employees contributed (.5% of their salary). How much did MCPS contribute to the supplemental program?
- The district's retiree healthcare program. So not counting healthcare expenses for current employees, what did the district spend on retiree healthcare?
- Unused sick leave. How much did it cost the district to pay recent retirees for the value of their earned leave?

I am responding on behalf of Montgomery County Public Schools as the director of the office that is responsible for replies to requests under the Maryland Public Information Act.

Please find enclosed responsive documents to your request.

If you believe you have been wrongly denied a public record, you are entitled to seek judicial review of this decision pursuant to GP § 4-362. In addition, pursuant to GP § 4-1B-01 et seq., you also have the option to express any concerns about this decision to the Public Access Ombudsman.
